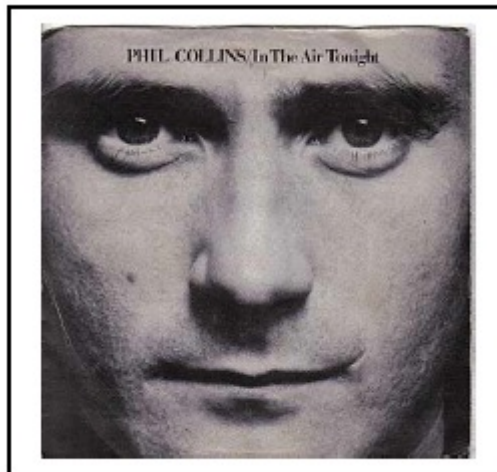


# PHIL COLLINS, *ANOTHER DAY IN PARADISE*.
